Nature Trails

Oak Grove Park

A short and level walk through an oak grove with seasonal creek. Several picnic tables and park benches along the path. Wildlife often spotted along this walk include Western Bluebirds, Acorn Woodpeckers, Red-shouldered Hawks, Nuthatches and Jack Rabbits.

Enter Oak Grove Park off the golf course path at the end of the Timber Creek Golf Course parking lot.



Central Park Preserve

A level walk through open fields with seasonal vernal pools. Occasional park bench along the path. Wildlife often spotted along this walk include Snowy Egrets, Great Blue Herons, Red-tailed Hawks, Pheasant and Jack Rabbits.

Enter Central Park Preserve off Del Webb Blvd across from the Timber Creek Golf Course parking lot.



School House Park

A lovely park complete with walking trails, historic gravesite and an amphitheater. There are several picnic tables and park benches. Wildlife you may see include Grey Squirrels, Jack Rabbits and a variety of birds and hawks.

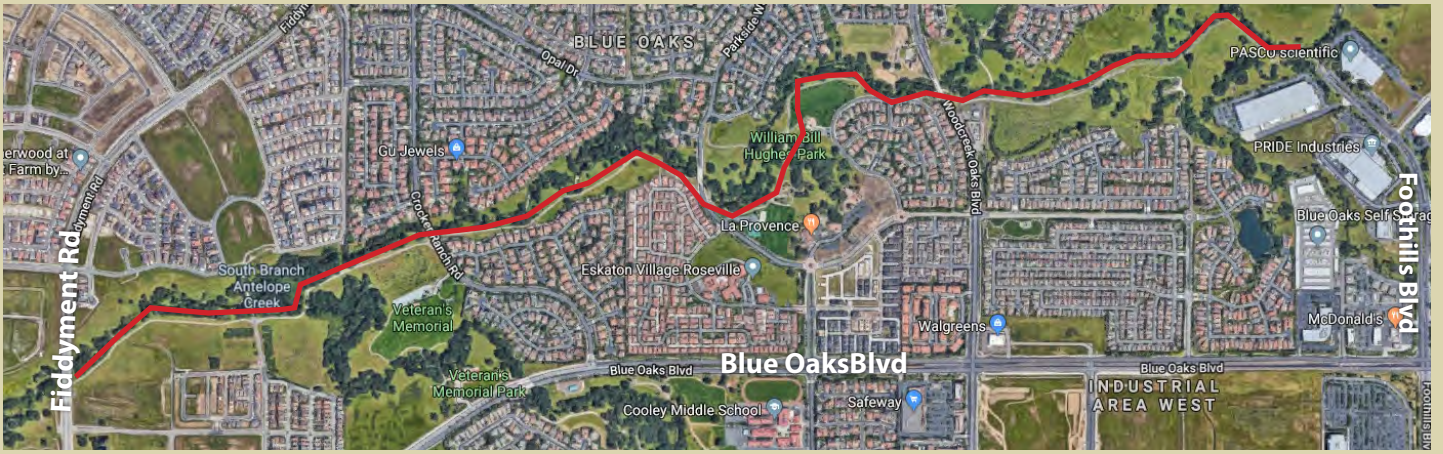
Enter School House Park from School House Lane or from Fiddymment Rd.



Cart Path

A short and level walk along the edge of Timber Creek Golf Course. Wildlife that may be spotted at the pond include Great Blue Herons, Great Egrets, Snowy Egrets and Green Herons.

Enter the Cart Path near the Sun City Blvd entrance at the Waterfall or from Rose Creek Rd.



Pleasant Grove Creek Trail

Pleasant Grove Creek Trail is a 5.6 mile moderately trafficked out and back trail that offers the chance to see wildlife. The trail is good for all skill levels and primarily used for walking, trail running, and nature trips. Dogs are also able to use this trail but must be kept on leash.



Blue Oaks Park

Pleasant Grove Creek Trail via Dirt Trail and Bike Path is a 2.9 mile moderately trafficked loop trail that features beautiful wild flowers and is good for all skill levels. The trail offers a number of activity options and is accessible year-round. Dogs are also able to use this trail.



Mahany Nature Preserve

Partially managed by Sun City Roseville, the Mahany Nature Preserve offers several trails that wander through oaks and grasslands with vernal pools and a variety of wildlife. The park stretches from Fiddymont to Woodcreek Oaks Blvd.
